## Orphans and Vulnerable Children

A baby was crying. The boys who washed cars by the creek followed the sound. In the tall grass they found a baby boy. He was weak and had been there overnight. A woman helped the boys and took the baby to the police. Child welfare took the baby to ACTION Gulu where he was placed at Home of Love Orphanage for Vulnerable Children. The Dorm Mothers at Home of Love named him Moses because he was found by the water. He was taken for a medical exam and blood test. He tested negative for HIV/AIDS. He was severely malnourished. At 1 ½ yrs old he could sit up but was too weak to stand. The police are looking for his relatives. Moses is just one of the children at Home of Love Orphanage for Vulnerable Children, a ministry of ACTION Gulu.



Home of Love Orphanage for Vulnerable Children is a ministry of ACTION Gulu. Home of Love was opened to meet the needs of orphans and vulnerable children in war-torn Northern Uganda. As a result of a war that lasted over 23 years, the region has been devastated. The LRA Rebels have killed people and abducted children. Families have been destroyed and people have been displaced.

Children are referred to Home of Love from the Ugandan Government Child Welfare office and other organizations that look out for the welfare of children. Many of the children are AIDS/WAR orphans who have lost their parents. Other children have been rescued from crisis situations such as abandonment and physical violence.

Home of Love offers these children a Christ-centered, safe and loving environment. The children receive trauma counseling, housing, food, medical treatment, clothing and life skills training. A staff social worker seeks to locate relatives of children brought to Home of Love. Due to the war many people have been displaced and separated from their families. Whenever possible children are reunited with their relatives and supported in the relatives home through payment of school fees, basic necessities, medical assistance and regular home visits by the on staff social worker.

## Child Sponsorship Program

The Home of Love Child Sponsorship Program links donors with children. The donors have the opportunity to make an impact in the lives of these children. The donors receive pictures and letters from their sponsored child. The funds provide for living expenses, medical costs and education fees. To cover these costs multiple sponsors are necessary for each child.

Home of Love has dormitories, cook house, dining hall, borehole, playing field, gardens and an on-site nursery school. Financial support for this ministry comes from individual donors and churches. Their support makes it possible to care for these vulnerable children. The children will have a chance to heal from their trauma and move forward with their lives. The mission of Home of Love is to raise the children in a godly environment where they can experience the love of Christ, receive an education and have hope for the future.
